

VAL-D'ILLIEZ TOURISM PILOT PROJECT

Tourism has evolved radically over the last decades. New technologies, changing consumer behaviour, omnipresent social media, the quest for a more collaborative economy, and ever more sophisticated mobile devices have contributed to a complete transformation of the tourist industry. Even the way guests get their information has changed - now that everyone is armed with a smartphone and non-stop access to news and information. This explains the decrease in attendance recorded by many tourist offices, including Region Dents du Midi.


While the traditional tourist info point still has a role to play as a welcoming space where clients can browse brochures and get personalised information, destinations that want to stand out must innovate! This is the thought process behind RDDM's latest venture - a virtual information centre at the Val-d'Illiez train station. This resolutely forward-looking, proactive technology will allow us to optimise resources while maintaining our close relationship with our customers.

Just how will it work? The centrepiece of this info point is a tactile video screen. Clients can initiate a video call and one of our friendly tourist agents will appear on-screen for a face-to-face consultation. A well-stocked display of helpful brochures will complete the virtual info point.

We are confident that this dynamic, modern concept will be a great way for us to stay up-to-date and efficient. This winter 2022-2023, we'll be testing the project out in Val-d'Illiez, but if the results are as positive as we anticipate, we might expand into other parts of our destination that aren't served by a local tourist office (Les Crosets and Champoussin for example).

This first virtual info point will be replacing the office located in the Place du Village, which was taken over on October 1st by the new socio-cultural activity coordinator for the Illiez Valley*.

* A project initiated by the 3 Illiez Valley municipalities to provide activities and infrastructure for young people throughout the region.



MORGINS GETS A LIFT

After 40 years of loyal service, the iconic La Foilleuse 3-man detachable chairlift will be retired to make way for a next generation, fully autonomous gondola lift, making Morgins just the second resort in Switzerland to feature this type of lift!

Following the merger of the Swiss Portes du Soleil lift companies, the newly-formed Board of Directors went to work hammering out a strategic investment plan for the next 20 years. Taking climate change and technological advances into account, the strategy aims to develop and restructure the area's facilities, with the clear goal of accentuating 4-season operation.

As part of this plan, the Board decided to retire the La Foilleuse chairlift and replace it with a gondola. Equipped with 38 comfortable cabins providing 10 places each, this lift will significantly increase the speed of access from Morgins to Les Portes du Soleil - from a theoretical 1,800 people per hour to an actual flow of 2,100 people per hour. But with a price tag of some 18 million Swiss Francs, this is more than just a simple lift replacement. The package also includes fitting out both top and bottom stations with all the infrastructure and logistics necessary to comfortably operate the entire Champoussin-Morgins sector. The new infrastructure will include ticket windows, ski lockers, staff changing and meeting rooms, a cabin garage for maintenance and cleaning, a workshop, a first-aid station, a snow groomer shed, and more.

Work is scheduled to start at the end of the 2022-2023 winter season. Phase one will involve dismantling the current installation. Phase two will include construction of the new installation, using the same footprint as the old lift. This must all be done within a precise, 8-month window, in order to begin operation for the 2023-2024 winter season.

Unless there is a delay in the authorisation procedure—which could potentially incur a one-year postponement due to the absolute incompressibility of the work to be done within the timeframe - there will be no operation for summer 2023, while construction is in progress. This is unfortunately an inescapable but necessary constraint to guarantee commissioning in December 2023.





LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!

We think the Chablais is incredibly photogenic, but don't just take our word for it! Here are four new productions sponsored by Region Dents du Midi.

LA ZONE (RÉAL. J. ROSERENS – 2022)

In the early 2000s, David Vladyka and a handful of snowboarders 'discovered' the Col de Cou, a remote pass on the Franco-Swiss border with breathtaking topography and a long history shrouded in mystery. Once whispered about as a passage for smuggling goods and refugees in wartime, in the 2000's the Col de Cou became become a legendary pilgrimage spot for freestyle snowboarding! Twenty years later, the snowboarders' showy effervescence has given way to splitboards and ski touring. A page has turned, and the slopes are pristine once again. Nevertheless. Mat Schaer and David Vladyka, veteran snowboarders from back in the day, still return from time to time to rekindle the old flame - this film retraces that journey and the incredible destiny of this unique place. Directed by Julien Roserens. La Zone was selected by the Banff Film Festival jury, one of the most renowned mountain film festivals in the world

FORTERESSE (RÉAL. L. ISLIKER – 2022)

After the huge success of their first film 'Teeth', which has nearly 150,000 views on YouTube, Dutch freeriders Loic Isliker and Paul De Groot offer up a new opus showcasing the formidable Couloir de la Forteresse. Combining an e-bike approach and advice of our famous local guide, Jacky Pochon, the film garnered praise from the public during its screenings at the High Five Film Festival and the Champéry Film Festival.

LES FICHIERS MURET (RÉAL. N. BOSSARD – 2022)

In the early days of the 20th century, Ernest Muret received an assignment to create a repertory of Swiss Romandy place names and the Chablais mountains. In this quest, the earnest Ernest cris-crossed our region and left extensive archives. This painstaking work allowed the film's two protagonists to rediscover our heritage with modern-day paralpinism, a mixture of mountaineering and wingsuit or paraglider flight. As they retrace Ernest's steps, they meet different people, layering a human element onto the impervious mountains and glorious panoramas in this unique and beautiful film.

VERS LES SOMMETS (Réal. JB Bieuville - Evoq — 2022)

Paul says he's been running for as long as he can remember. Living and working abroad when the unexpected challenges of recent years turned his life upside down, he decided to start over with something completely different - he became a serious trail runner with the goal of running the Dents du Midi Trail. As his training programme progresses, he discovers hidden depths to his quest - and that the mountain has much more to offer than just spectacular topography. Directed by Jean-Baptiste Bieuville, this short film was selected for the Cannes Indie Shorts Award, the Xplore Alpes Festival, and the Diablerets International Film Festival (FIFAD).



AUTUMN ADVENTURES

RDDM BRINGS ROMANDY TO BALLENBERG

This autumn, the Ballenberg open-air museum in the Bernese Oberland hosted the 'Fête des Fêtes', or Festival of Festivals. Over two weekends, on September 24-25 and October 1-2, 2022, no less than fifteen regions gathered in the picturesque museum grounds to showcase their autumn traditions and celebrate Switzerland's cultural diversity. Region Dents du Midi is proud to have been chosen by the Cantonal Agriculture Service to represent Valais Romandy in partnership with the Cavagne farm-totable shops and the Illiez Valley Agricultural Society (SAVI). Over the weekend, we regaled crowds of museumgoers with folk dancing by 'Champéry 1830' and 'Val-d'Illiez 1830', traditional flag throwing demonstrations, cheerful folk music, and delicious culinary specialties from the Illiez Valley. Visitors of all ages braved torrential rains to visit with cute. black-nosed sheep and Opaline, our now-famous St Bernard, and watch the iconic black Hérens cows (we call them 'Queens') in their instinctive battles for dominance within the herd. As predicted, it was an epic festival to beat all festivals!

ONCE UPON A TIME...

There once was an old border outpost. Who would guess that this quiet corner of alpine wilderness once used to be a thoroughfare for smuggling? Back in the day, wary customs officers were posted here, spending dark nights on the lookout for any unusual activity. Today the outpost has been completely renovated and renamed the Ancienne Douane 1820. With a capacity for six people, this is the perfect spot for a fun group getaway. Accessible by road only in summer, wintertime visitors will need to make the trip on touring skis or snowshoes. The effort is well worth the reward at this cosy refuge surrounded by alpine wilderness and the ghostly remnants of a rich and fascinating past.

MOUNTAIN DESTINATIONS AT THE HEART OF ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING

To consolidate RDDM's long-standing commitment to sustainable development (ISO 14'001 certification in 2018 and Swisstainable level III in 2022), we have joined Summit Foundation's **Sustainable Mountains** program, in partnership with the ski lift company Portes du Soleil Suisse SA.

Over the next three years, this program plans to tackle thirteen commitments which can be regrouped by four themes: sustainability management, waste management, environmental communication, and restoration. These engagements will be put into practice through a series of workshops presenting good practices, boots-on-the-ground actions to raise awareness among visitors, personnel training, sustainability indicators monitoring, an eco-responsible office solutions charter, and brainstorming new directions for the region's future.

This approach aims both to further establish our position and to help us stand out. We are convinced it will also help reduce costs, streamline our processes, reduce our environmental impact, solidify existing sustainability measures, and guide community development and the creation of new solutions and skills. Overall, RDDM wants to be the vector of durable, quality tourism, centred around two principal axes:

- > Sustainable, responsible economic development
- > Environmental protection



LOWER VALAIS MUSIC FESTIVAL MAY 26TH - 28TH 2023

The Lower-Valais Music Festival is a once-a-year extravaganza that showcases our Federation of 23 music societies. Each year, the festival is organised by a different brass band - Champéry has hosted the festival 4 times, in 1908, 1953, 1974, and 1997 and our much-loved Écho de la Montagne brass band is proud to announce they will be renewing the honour in 2023.

On Friday, as per tradition, the organisers will receive their neighbouring groups - in this case, Val-d'Illiez, Troistorrents, and Morgins - kicking off the festivities by taking turns on stage. This will be followed by a special production from the Monthey Dance Center, a local dance school that has won ten Swiss championships in showdance training, not to mention countless solo, duo, and group titles. This promises to be a spectacular, showstopping evening where theatricality, choreography, dance, music, and song overlap and celebrate jazz, rock, and French variety music.

Saturday is dedicated to encouraging young musicians, a vitally important part of this festival. Join us for a competition featuring some 150 young talents, all ready to blow your socks off and become the next virtuoso. In the evening, the young frontwomen of the Zurchettes and Ze Band will kick off the evening with rock, pop, reggae, and funk covers, before turning the stage over to Long Live the Queen, the ultimate Queen tribute show!

Sunday, the official day of the Lower Valais Music Festival, is a joyous cacophony of pomp and circumstance and pageantry. From daybreak, the hills will come alive to the sounds of brass, woodwind, percussion, and drums. Some 1,000 musicians from the 22 companies present will perform an ensemble piece, before returning to their respective companies to perform in front of a jury. The day will also include outdoor concerts and a magnificent parade through the streets of Champéry for the marching band competition.
